Our funding application of \$950,000.00 has been successfully accepted by MPI, marking the beginning of an exciting journey for the Kaweka Community Catchment Collective (KCCC). Over the next three years, we have the opportunity to implement impactful projects and initiatives that will positively impact our rural community and catchments. We are incredibly grateful to MPI for accepting this application and we are all very excited to put these resources to good use.

JOIN THE KCCC

One of our primary objectives in this initial phase is to appoint Hub Champs for the four different Hubs, Puketitiri, Patoka, Rissington and Dartmoor. As a hub champ you will play a pivotal role in representing your hub, providing direct input and helping to steer the direction of our collective efforts. This position will be determined through a voting process within each hub, and the benefits and responsibilities will be discussed further with interested candidates.
